Interspersing archival, ethnographic and mnemonic practices with a reading of photographic images from the colonial past and the present, the inaugural lecture builds a narrative, suggestive of a way of 'doing history' of the city of Dehli by way of two cataclysmic events, 1857 and 1947, while carrying the story forward into 1957 and the present - the time of the adolescence and the hardened maturity of the nation state.

Prof. Shahid Amin occupies the A.M. Khwaja Chair which is currently attached to the Department of History and Culture, Jamia Millia Islamia. Prof. Amin was previously a faculty member of the Department of History, University of Delhi. Author of many significant books and articles on the economic and social history of colonial India, Professor Amin's latest work is *Conquest and Community: The afterlife of warrior saint Ghazi Miyan* (Chicago, 2016)
