Extended Abstract/Paper Guidelines

- The participants must submit the extended abstract of the paper between 1500 - 3000 words or full paper not exceeding 6000 words in Microsoft word document, Font size -12, Times New Roman, single line spacing, and five keywords.
- The abstract must indicate the objectives, methodology, significant results, implications, and critical references.
- The extended abstracts/full papers will be scrutinized and finalized by the editorial committee.
- The criteria for evaluation by the reviewers are based on relevance, methodology, and originality.
- It must include the author's name (s), affiliation (s), full postal address, email ID, mobile number, and the paper's title on the front page.
- The extended abstract/full paper must be submitted through email at events.dms@jmi.ac.in
- Contributors who are unable to travel to India would be accommodated through videoconferencing.

Registration

All such authors and co-author(s) must register if they want to get the conference certificate. At least one person among the author or co-author has to be present for presenting the paper.
