Born in 1956 in Oviedo, Fernando Beltrán moved to Madrid in 1964 and studied at the Complutense University. In 1982, his book *Aquelarre en Madrid* won him Adonáis Prize. In 1987, he wrote the manifesto *Perdimos la palabra* (We Lost the Word) in the Madrid daily *El País*, and later he authored *Hacia una poesía entrometida* in the *Leer* magazine. Currently he edits the magazine *El hombre de la calle* (Man from the Street).

His works have been translated into fifteen languages.
