### FTK-Centre for Information Technology – A Brief Background

Established in 1984 as a Computer Centre with the objective of providing central computing facility to the students and staff of the University, it took more than fifteen years to transform it to a full-fledged Centre for Information Technology with the latest ICT facilities and services. Ever since its inception, the Centre has played pivotal role in developing and implementing IT services and applications in Jamia. To offer IT services to the end users in the University, it has established a campus wide network of 2700 nodes. In addition, for easy access to applications and services, the CIT has setup a number of WiFi hotspots within the University Campus. The CIT is also responsible for development and implementation of University Management Information System. Presently, the University ERP consists of 18 modules and is being extensively used in the day-today activities of the University. In addition, the Centre manages the University website, E-Mailing system and other useful Intranet services. The Centre is continuously striving to bridge the gap between the IT and the end users for optimum utilization of the IT resources. To achieve this endeavor, it continuously arranges various IT training programs, extension lectures and workshops for its users.

### About the Conference

With overwhelming success of the first Conference on Sustainable Development and Management of Information Technology in Universities and Colleges organized by FTK-Center For Information Technology, Jamia Millia Islamia in February 2009, it is obligatory for us to provide the same platform to all IT Professionals working in Indian Universities once again.
