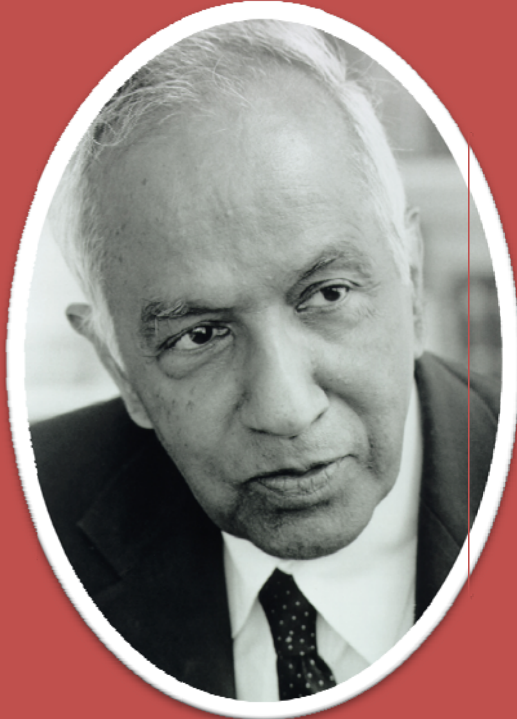


The Legacy of **SUBRAHMANYAN CHANDRASEKHAR** (1910-1995)
