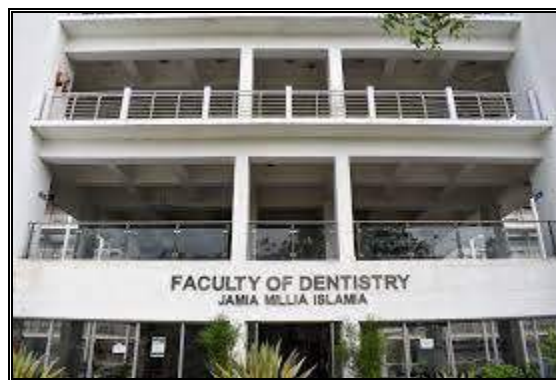

Event Report of Anti-ragging Workshop dated 28.03.2023 (Tuesday) 11.30-12.30 at Library , Faculty of Dentistry, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi

A workshop on Anti-ragging was organized by Faculty of Dentistry, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi on Tuesday 28.03.2023 from 11.30am-12.30pm in Library of Faculty of Dentistry. This workshop is mandated by Dental Council of India to increase awareness among students about the menace of ragging. Total 115 participants including 70 students of first and second year BDS, 35 Faculty members and 10 non-teaching staff attended the Anti-ragging workshop.



Prof Keya Sircar, Dean, Faculty of Dentistry, the organizing chairperson Dr Deep Inder & co-organizing chairperson Dr Nupur Gupta facilitated the workshop. The session began with the recitation of Holy Q'uran verses. Prof Keya Sircar, welcomed the Honorable Chief Guest Dr Puneet Batra, DCI nominee & Prof Atiqur Rahman, chief proctor & In charge security,JMI. Prof Atiqur Rehman emphasized the importance of conducting anti ragging workshop, although no such incidence has been reported in JMI campus. He appreciated the initiative taken by Faculty of Dentistry for conducting such workshop.

Prof Deep Inder Introduced the resource person Dr Puneet Batra, Director Board of studies, Manav Rachna Dental College, Faridabad Haryana and central Govt. nominee to DCI. He is highly accomplished person in the field of Orthodontics and implant dentistry with several awards and publications to his credit. Guest speaker Dr Puneet Batra very nicely covered impact of ragging menace on physical and

psychological well being of students, the laws and provisions by Indian Penal Code (IPC) Acts, redressal systems and committees under DCI and working institutions, contact numbers, websites and importance and role of student counsellors. While explaining that the student perceptions of Ragging may vary, he emphasized that students should feel free to contact their teachers and Head of the institution in case of any adverse event.

The talk was followed by a very interactive question - answer session. Several queries raised by students and faculty members were addressed very effectively by speaker.
