Abstract

The research study highlights the significance of Communication Skill as an essential component of life. In today's competitive world, communication skills are the most sought after quality of an educated person. Reading, writing, listening carefully and speaking are crucial communication skills for students and teachers. Being able to communicate effectively is the most important of all life skills. The art of communication involves listening and speaking as well as reading and writing. Teachers need to be highly skilled in all these areas to excel in their profession. Proficient communicators receive information, understand and synthesize it and express themselves at a high level. Communication is stated to be effective when it cudgels up a response from the recipient.
