**Amendment in the Examination Rules
to Facilitate International Mobility of Students and
Acceptance of Credit for Papers taken in a Partner
Foreign University**

1. These amendments are aimed at facilitating international mobility of students between Jamia Millia Islamia (herein after referred to as JMI) and its Partner Foreign Universities;
2. These amendments would be applicable to all courses of JMI. For the purposes of these amendments, the nomenclature "course" in JMI would mean a "programme of study" in the Foreign Partner University while a "paper" in JMI would mean a "course of study" in the Foreign Partner University;
3. A Partner Foreign University would mean a foreign university/academic institution with which the JMI has entered into Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which provides for exchange of students for an academic year or a semester;
4. The JMI shall have the following provisions inserted in its Examination Rules:
 - a. A bonafide student of a Partner Foreign University may be permitted to join course in JMI for an academic year or for a single semester, with the prior consent of the concerned Head of Department, Dean of the Faculty or Director of the Centre;
 - b. An inbound exchange student described under 4(a) above may be permitted to take some or all of the papers prescribed for the course, which he/she joins and that he/ she would be issued Marks Sheet (s) for the papers that he/ she has successfully completed;

- c. A bonafide student of JMI, as selected by the Partner University, may be permitted to join a course in the Partner University for a single semester or an academic year. Such a student shall herein after referred to as outbound exchange student;
- d. An outbound exchange student shall be required to obtain prior approval of the concerned Head of department/ Dean of the Faculty or Director of the Centre before joining a partner University abroad;
- e. While granting approval to such request the Head of the Department/ Dean of the Faculty / Director of the Centre shall ensure -
 - i. That the said student agrees to take as many papers or equivalent thereof in the Partner University as he/she may be required to take in JMI during the concerned semester/ academic year
 - ii. That the said student agrees that he/ she shall not take those or similar papers as he/ she had already studied in JMI in the course that he is presently pursuing;
 - iii. That the said student is allowed to join a course in a partner University for a semester only if he is enrolled in semester based course; a student pursuing a course in Jamia Millia Islamia that has annual examination system should be required to join a Partner Foreign University for at least two semesters in a row;
- f. The papers taken and successfully completed by the outbound exchange student, in the Partner Foreign University shall be accepted by JMI for the award of degree from JMI, as if those papers were taken and completed in JMI.

g. Given the variations in temporal plan and evaluation pattern, the following may be adopted as a basis for equivalence:

- i. A 2 credit course (paper) of a semester taken in a Partner University shall be accepted by JMI as equivalent to 50 Marks of a Semester programme;
- ii. A 3 or 4 credit course (paper) of a semester taken in a Partner University shall be accepted by JMI as equivalent to 100 marks;
