**Amendment in Para 5  
 of**

**Ordinance 5 (V) [Academic]  
 "ADMISSION AND ENROLLMENT OF STUDENTS"**

Para No.	Existing	Proposed amendment
5.1	<p>A student of the 1st Year/1st Semester of any course who is detained due to shortage of attendance will no longer remain a student of the University. Such a student will have to seek fresh admission and will be required to go through the entire admission process. Provided that a student of 1st Year/1st Semester of any course who fails in the Annual/Semester-end Examination or who could not take the examination for reasons other than shortage of attendance, will not be readmitted. However, he/she may be allowed to appear as an Ex-Student in the consecutive Annual/1st Semester-end Examination.</p>	<p><b>5. Re-admission</b></p> <p>5.1 A student of the 1st Year/1st Semester of any course who is detained due to shortage of attendance will no longer remain a student of the University. Such a student will have to seek re-admission.</p> <p>5.1.1 If a student of 1st Year/1st semester of any course who fails in the Annual/Semester-end Examination or who could not take the examination for reasons other than shortage of attendance may be allowed to appear as an Ex-student in the consecutive Annual/1st Semester-end Examination.</p>
