"Fellowships, Scholarships and Gold Medals for Students"

Para No.	Existing	Amended
5		<p><i>Add the following new para:</i></p> <p>5. Leave Entitlement for UGC Non-NET Fellows.</p> <p>Leave for a maximum period of 30 days in a year, in addition to public holidays, may be taken by a Ph.D. student who has been awarded UGC Non-NET Fellowship, with the approval of the Ph.D. Supervisor. However, he/she will not be entitled to any other vacations, for example, summer, winter etc.</p> <p>Women awardees will be eligible for "maternity leave" at full rates of the fellowship for 135 days as per Government of India rules once during the tenure of her award.</p> <p>The awardee may in special cases be allowed leave without fellowship/associateship and contingency by the University Grants Commission for a period not exceeding three months during the tenure of award, on the recommendation of the Ph.D. Supervisor/ Head of the Department concerned. The period of leave without fellowship/associateship will be counted towards the tenure.</p>
