Multidisciplinary (MD): Students of BTTM will choose Multidisciplinary courses offered by the department, an online course approved by the department or from a pool of Multidisciplinary courses offered by Faculties of Humanities & Languages, Social Sciences, Sciences, or Fine Arts.

Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): Students of DTHM will choose Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) offered by the department or an online course approved by the department.

Compulsory for those who seek exit after 1st Year (Exit-I). *Compulsory for those who seek exit after 2nd Year (Exit-II). **** (Exit-III) For those who have not taken exit either in I or II Year.

Department will also approve a pool of 4 credit Exit Courses from which a student will choose one course if he/she decides to exit the course so as to enable them to acquire a certificate/ diploma/ degree.

If required, a department may add additional courses/credits to the Major or Minor components in consultation with the Dean of Faculty, Timetable In charge & in coordination with COE's office to accommodate requirement of their specific disciplines while not overburdening the students.
