The Department of Economics, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI), in collaboration with Indian Society for Ecological Economics (INSEE) organized a Panel Discussion on "Demand-side Solutions for Mitigating Climate Change" by authors of Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) Assessment Report 6 on June 5, 2023, on MS Team platform as part of Celebration of World Environment Day. The eminent panellists were Leila Niamir (Research Scholar with Transformative Institutional and Social Solutions Research Group and Sustainable Service Systems Research Group at International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis, Austria) and Keigo Akimoto (Group Leader, Systems Analysis Group and Chief Researcher, Research Institute of Innovative Technology for the Earth, and Specially Appointed Professor, Institute of Innovative Research, Tokyo Institute of Technology, Japan). The event was moderated by Joyashree Roy (Founder Director, Centre on South and South East Asia Multidisciplinary Applied Research Network on Transforming Societies of Global South, Asian Institute of Technology, Thailand, and member, INSEE).

The programme was co-chaired by Prof. Asheref Illiyan, Head, Dept. of Economics, JMI and Nilanjan Ghosh, Director, Centre for New Diplomacy and Observer Research Foundation, Kolkata, and President, INSEE. Prof. Nandan Nawn, Dept. of Economics, JMI and member, INSEE was the coordinator of the programme.

Dr.Ghosh in his introductory address emphasized that climate change is more of a developmental and less of an environmental problem. He advocated transdisciplinary approaches through demand side mitigation for addressing the problem.

Prof. Roy provided an introduction to the reports by IPCC, including the last one on 1.5°C. She mentioned that for the first time, demand side measures were included in the IPCC Assessment Reports that has multiple co-benefits. She emphasized on the inequality aspects of energy consumption—how high socio-economic status contributes to much higher emission than by those who are having low socio-economic status.

Dr. Niamir identified three sets of factors towards demand-side mitigation: socio-cultural, infrastructural design, and technological. For each, she provided detailed explanation along with examples on reduction of energy use. Examples were taken from possibilities of digitalization, sharing economy and circular economy, under each of the three factors.

Prof.Akimoto shared possible energy demand reductions across regions, worldwide, in case of adoption of steps such as ride-and-car sharing, virtual meeting and teleworking, e- publication, recycling and reduction in apparels, among others.

The panel discussion was followed by a thought provoking question answer session. Vote of thanks was offered by Prof. Nawn, Department of Economics, JMI.

In another event, the Centre for the Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy, JMI organised a Plantation Drive to celebrate the World Environment Day 2023 at the Lawn of the Noam Chomsky Complex, Gate No. 19, JMI. The drive was launched by the Hony. Director Prof. Arvinder Ansari, Faculty members, Staff and Students of the Centre in order to create a green, clean and healthy environment in and around campus which will go a long way in making the campus environment friendly. It will also help to sensitize students towards the need to preserve our environment and ecology. Most of the plants planted on the occasion were herbal plants which would have motivated the students to keep their surroundings green and clean and also understand the importance of the herbal plants.

All the students who joined the event expressed their interest in the event and suggested that such drives should be organized at regular intervals in order to create a healthy environment. With this all felt inner peace for something good for the environment.

(MCX) on 11.10.2023 at Conference Hall, Dr. Zakir Husain Central Library, JMI. This seminar was part of SEBI's Celebration of World Investor Week (WIW). WIW, an initiative of International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO), is celebrated every year, across the world, by the securities market regulators. The week witnesses a host of investor awareness activities across the globe. WIW – 2023 is being celebrated in India from October 09-15, 2023. Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) is the national coordinator for celebrating WIW-2023 in India.

The seminar commenced with the opening remarks by Prof. Asheref Illiyan, Head, Department of Economics, JMI. He welcomed the keynote speaker, faculty members and students and expressed his satisfaction that Department of Economics, JMI has been fortunate to be part of this great initiative of IOSCO and SEBI.

The program has got overwhelming response from young faculty members and research scholars across the departments/centres of JMI such as Department of Social Work, Tourism and Hospitality Management, Economics, Centre for International Relations, Centre for Physiotherapy, Faculty of Education and Faculty of Architecture etc. The workshop was held in offline mode in the computer lab of the Department. Prof. Muslim Khan, Dean Faculty of Social Sciences, JMI was the Chief Guest at the inaugural function. He commenced his inaugural address by narrating the philosophy of research starting from Ancient Greek Philosophers- Socrates and Plato to the present. He emphasised the significance of "data" in the present data driven world and explained proper use of data to enhance the authenticity of results derived. He also stressed the need for having societal applications of research.

Prof. Asheref Illiyan, Head, Department of Economics JMI & Workshop Director, in his opening remarks emphasised the importance of such workshops for a cutting edge research across the disciplines and for research skill enhancement. He also highlighted the importance of learning intuitive logic behind research tools and effective interpretation of statistical reults.

Prof. Moonis Shakeel, Department of Economics, JMI & organising secretary elaborated importance of data management and presented an overview of the SPSS software. Dr,Md. Zakaria Siddiqui, Associate Professor, Department of Economics, JMI &coordinator of the workshop explained foundational aspects of sampling theory to set the stage for hypothesis testing for making informed decision regarding the acceptance or rejection of the research hypothesis along with the practical examples.

Dr,Mohd Kashif Khan, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, JMI & coordinator of the workshop, elaborated different types of non- parametric tests such as Chi-square test, Mann-Whitney Wilcoxon test and Kruskal Wallis test and their applications in empirical research.





JMI organizes Global Conclave on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

New Delhi, March 14: The Department of Economics, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) organised the Global Conclave on Sustainable Development Goals: Progress, Challenges and Way Forward during 6-7th March 2024. The conclave started off with welcome remarks by Prof. Asheref Illiyan, Head Department of Economics, JMI and Conference Director. Prof. Partha Sen, Former Director, Delhi School of Economics delivered the Presidential address.

Prof. Sen emphasized over the conflicting objectives of the government, i.e., on the one hand Governments wish to achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and on the other hand Governments also need to achieve fiscal and monetary balance. While realization of SDGs includes achieving a certain minimum level of stock variables such as public health, Nutrition , education, etc. which plays a crucial role in sustained growth of the economy. However, the need for achieving fiscal and monetary balance in every consecutive period forces the government to curtail spending and credits. While the Global North has largely solved the problem of its stock variables and is exclusively concerned about managing macro balance of flow variables, the global south continues to grapple with improving their stock variables broadly captured by human development indicators.

Dr. Rajan Sudesh Ratna, Deputy Head and Senior Economic Affairs Officer, United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UN-ESCAP), South and South West Asia Office, in his inaugural speech, appreciated that SDGs are relevant to and responsibility of every individual and organisation in the world. He iterated that we are far off from achieving targets for 89% of the indicators in the region as per UN-ESCAP report. While identifying the challenges countries face in achievement of SDGs, he emphasize the role of the researchers in helping governments to make evidence-based policy interventions.

Mr. Uchita De Zoysa, Chairman, Global Sustainability Solutions (GLOSS), Executive Director, Centre for Environment & Development (CED), Colombo, Sri Lanka, said that notwithstanding the slow and dissatisfactory progress, fundamental idea behind SDGs is to transform the world in terms of thinking around the global challenges and not merely to achieve targets by countries.

After the inaugural session, Ist Plenary session began with highly reputed speakers such as Prof. Achin Chakraborty, Former Director, Institute of Development Studies Kolkata, Prof. Santosh Mehrotra, Former Chairperson, Centre for Informal Sector and Labour Studies, JNU, New Delhi and Visiting Professor, Centre for Development Economics, University of Bath, UK, Prof. Kavita Rao, Director, National Institute of Public Finance and Policy (NIPFP) and Dr. Tauhidur Rahman, Founding Director, Initiative for Agency and Development (IFAD) and Associate Professor, Department of Agricultural and Resource Economics, University of Arizona, United States of America (USA). Prof. Achin laid emphasis on utilising latest advances in professional economic

theory to analyse issues that are highly relevant for SDG related target indicators. Prof. Santosh Mehrotra weaved coherent story arguing that if human development precedes economic growth then we are more likely to achieve SDGs goals on poverty and inequality. Prof. Kavita Rao underscored the difficulty in achieving a uniform definition and measurement of spending that are relevant to SDGs. Dr. Tauhidur Rahman tried to rationalise gender dimensions in achievement of SDGs. He argued that India has been lacking in progress on Female Labour force participation primarily because we have not been able to address the gender norms that hinder the autonomy and agency of women.

Prof. Praveen Jha, JNU chaired the second Plenary session of the conclave. Prof. Arun Kumar, Former Professor, JNU, Prof. Joyashree Roy, Director-SMARTS Center, Asian Institute of Technology (AIT), Thailand. Prof. Srijit Mishra, Indira Gandhi Institute of Development Research (IGIDR), were speakers in the session. The focus of the session was on climate change and health related issues in sustainability. Prof. Arun Kumar hinted towards the current state of the global political economy that acts as a formidable impediment to sustainable development. In similar mode, Prof. Srijit Mishra using evidence from his recent publication in Current Science global reaction to COVID asserted that response to global poly crises such as COVID should have solid evidence base and be proportional to the crisis.

Prof. Joyashree's presentation tried to examine the workability for manual workers given the ambient temperature and humidity in metro cities of India. She found that more than 90% of days in any given year remain under non-workable zone until extreme solutions such as Air conditioning.

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

और दुनिया के प्रत्येक व्यक्ति और संगठन की जिम्मेदारी प्रासंगिक हैं। उन्होंने दोहराया कि हम युएन-ईएससीएपी रिपोर्ट के अनुसार क्षेत्र में 89% संकेतकों के लक्ष्य हासिल करने से बहत दर हैं। एसडीजी की उपलब्धि में देशों के सामने आने वाली चुनौतियों की पहचान करते हुए, उन्होंने सरकारों को साक्ष्य आधारित नीतिगत हस्तक्षेप करने में मदद करने में शोधकर्ताओं की भूमिका पर जोर दिया। श्री उचिता डी 3797191 जोयसा. ग्लोबल सस्टेनेबिलिटी सॉल्यूशंस (जीएलओएसएस), कार्यकारी निदेशक, सेंटर फॉर एनवायरनमेंट एंड एम्प; डेवलपमेंट (सीईडी), कोलंबो, श्रीलंका ने कहा कि धीमी और असंतोषजनक प्रगति के बावजुद, एसडीजी के पीछे मुल विचार वैश्विक चुनौतियों के बारे में सोचने के मामले में दुनिया को बदलना है, न कि केवल देशों द्वारा लक्ष्य हासिल करना।

उद्घाटन सत्र के बाद, पहला पूर्ण सत्र प्रतिष्ठित वक्ताओं जैसे प्रो. अचिन चक्रवर्ती, पूर्व निदेशक, इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ डेवलपमेंट स्टडीज कोलकाता, प्रो. संतोष मेहरोत्रा, पूर्व अध्यक्ष, सेंटर फॉर इनफॉर्मल सेक्टर एंड लेबर स्टडीज, जेएनयू, नई दिल्ली और विजिटिंग प्रोफेसर, सेंटर फॉर डेवलपमेंट इकोनॉमिक्स, यूनिवर्सिटी ऑफ बाथ, यूके, प्रोफेसर कविता राव, निदेशक, नेशनल इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ पब्लिक फाइनेंस एंड पॉलिसी (एनआईपीएफपी) और डॉ. तौहिदुर संस्थापक निदेशक, रहमान, इनिशिएटिव फॉर एजेंसी एंड डेवलपमेंट (आईएफएडी) और एसोसिएट प्रोफेसर, कृषि और संसाधन अर्थशास्त्र विभाग. एरिजोना विश्वविद्यालय, संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका (यूएसए) के साथ शुरू हुआ। प्रोफेसर अचिन ने एसडीजी से संबंधित लक्ष्य संकेतकों के लिए अत्यधिक प्रासंगिक मुद्दों का विश्लेषण करने के लिए पेशेवर आर्थिक सिद्धांत में नवीनतम प्रगति का उपयोग करने पर जोर दिया। प्रोफेसर संतोष मेहरोत्रा ने तर्क देते हुए सुसंगत कहानी बुनी कि यदि मानव विकास आर्थिक विकास से पहले होता है तो हमें गरीबी और असमानता पर एसडीजी लक्ष्यों को प्राप्त करने की अधिक संभावना है। प्रोफेसर कविता राव ने एसडीजी के लिए प्रासंगिक खर्च की एक समान परिभाषा और माप प्राप्त करने में कठिनाई को रेखांकित किया। डॉ. तौहिदुर रहमान ने एसडीजी की उपलब्धि में लैंगिक आयामों को तर्कसंगत बनाने का प्रयास किया। उन्होंने तर्क दिया कि भारत में महिला श्रम बल भागीदारी में प्रगति की कमी मख्य रूप से इसलिए है क्योंकि हम उन लिंग मानदंडों को संबोधित करने में सक्षम नहीं हैं जो महिलाओं की स्वायत्तता और एजेंसी में बाधा डालते हैं।





JMI's Department of Economics organizes Panel Discussion on Union Budget 2024 25

Expert's at JMI's Panel Discussion Question the Union Budget 2024-25's Ability to Stimulate the Economy

New Delhi: The Department of Economics, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) organized a Panel Discussion on the Union Budget 2024-25 on 06th August 2024, at the Model Class Room of the department. The event commenced with opening remarks by Prof. Asheref Illiyan, Head of the Department, who outlined the all-encompassing nine priorities presented by the Finance Minister in the union budget 2024-25. The distinguished panellists of the event were: Prof. Pulin B Nayak, former Professor, Delhi School of Economics, and Prof. Arun Kumar, former Professor, Centre for Economic Studies and Planning (CESP), Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU). The session was moderated by Professor N. A. Azad, former Professor, Department of Economics, JMI.

Prof. Pulin addressed the gathering with retrospection on the Indian economy's journey to a three trillion economy and commented on the current state of the economy. He flagged his concern regarding the labour market in the economy where jobs growth and real wages have been sluggish which may have contributed to widening inequality. He emphasised that the budget usually allocates insufficient funds to the health and education sectors. India conventionally spends a significantly lower share of its GDP on social sectors compared to other countries which is true for this budget as well. He highlighted reduction in funding for University Grants Commission which may adversely affect public institutions of higher education. He also argued that growth of private universities will not be able to fill these gaps as the quality control of private higher education institutions is a major issue. He also commented on quality issues in primary education in India. Prof. Pulin concluded his speech by emphasising the need for more fund allocation to social sectors like education and health etc.

The second speaker, Prof. Arun Kumar, established the context by providing an overview of the economic and political underpinnings of the current budget. He highlighted the fact that the budget usually becomes confusing for common people because it often states projected 5-year expenditure instead of the exact amount that the Government is actually planning to spend in the immediate year of the budget. Further permission for loans are also announced as part of the budget statement.

Subsequently, he elaborated that allocations in the budget are not going to help the informal sector , as most employment related announcements are mainly going to help the formal sector. It was important to keep the informal sector in consideration during the budget process as it provides employment to 75% of the non-agricultural workforce in India. With regards to fiscal consolidation Prof. Kumar highlighted that budget should have explored new sources of revenue growth instead of curbing expenditure on social sector given the high levels of inequality the country is facing While summing up he iterated that the budget focuses on supply side policy options to boost the economy and employment but most experts indicate that Indian economy faces lack of effective demand implying that budget may not succeed in stimulating the economy.

Prof. N. A. Azad moderated the session, facilitating comments and further discussion on the panellists' presentations. He underscored that despite challenges India has advantages of the largest young population in the world and has been emerging as the best destination for foreign investment. The event concluded with a detailed question-andanswer session, where the audience raised comments, concerns, and questions.

The event was enthusiastically attended by students, research scholars, and faculty members from various departments and centres of the university. 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





इस कार्यक्रम के मुख्य करता, आईआईएमएडी के संस्थापक अध्यक्ष, प्रो इरुदया राजन ने इस बात को साझा किया कि सम्मेलन के बारे में कैसे सोचा गया, और इसके उद्देश्यों के बारे में और खास तीर मे

अंतरराष्ट्रीय प्रवासन के कारे में गंभीर चर्च करने के लिए पेशेवर, शिक्षविदों और नीति निर्माताओं को एक मंच पर लाने के बारे में विचार किया गया। उन्होंने इस बात पर प्रकाश डाला कि भारत पहले प्रकार के जनसाख्यिकीय लाभांश (मात्रात्मक) से लाभान्यित हो रहा है, लेकिन दूसरे प्रकार (गुणात्मक) से नहीं, इसके लिए कौशल विकास की आवश्यकता है। उन्होंने बताय कि एक राज्य (जैसे, केरल) के मजदूर खाड़ी देशों में जा रहे हैं. और उनके स्थान पर दूसरे राज्य (जैसे, ओडिशा) के मजदूर पलायन कर रहे हैं। उन्होंने इसे प्रतिस्थापन प्रवासन कहा। उनकी राय में, प्रवासन पहले से ही राजनीति का एक विषय अन गया है और वह भी अंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तर पर, जैसा कि हाल के अमेरिकी राष्ट्रपति चुनाव में देखा गया, और भारत में कई भारतीय राज्यों में सन अऑन दिन सॉयल तर्फ के माध्यम से देखा गया। उन्होंने पाया कि समय के साथ प्रवासन पर शोध करने

वाले शोधकर्ताओं की संख्या में अल्पधिक वृद्धि हुई है और विशेष रूप से कोविड महमारी के उपरांत से। उन्होंने प्रवास जनगणना का आह्वन किया जिस पर आंध्र प्रदेश में पहले से ही चर्चा चल ही है।

जवाहरलाल नेहरू विस्वविद्यालय के पूर्व प्रोफेसर प्रे अमिताभ कड़ ने अपनी संक्षिप्त टिप्पणी में प्रवासन पर विस्तृत डेटा की अपयोशता और डेटा जारी करने में देरी की ओर इशारा किया, जिसका बहुत कम महत्व है। उनके अनसार, जिले से जिले में प्रवासन डेटा शोधकर्ताओं के लिए बहुत मददगार होगा जिसे जनगणना आयुक्त के कार्यालय के थोड़े ही प्रयास से एकत्रित किया जा सकता है। जामिया के सामाजिक विज्ञान संकाय के डीन प्रो मोहम्मद मसिलम खान ने बताय कि सम्मेलन में भाग लेने वाले अधिकांश लोग प्रवासी हैं। उन्होंने प्रवासियों के साथ होने वाले विभिन्न प्रकार के दुर्व्यवहारों और शोषण के बारे में बताया। उन्होंने मेजव्यन और गंतव्य देशों की सरकारों के बीच प्रवासन और अंतरराष्ट्रीय संबंधों के बीच संबंध की ओर भी इशारा किया। सम्मेलन सचिव डॉ. मोहम्मद जकारिया सिदीको ने धन्यवाद ज्ञापित किया। उद्घाटन समारोह के अतिरिक्त सम्मेलन में तीन पूर्ण सत्र और छह तकनीकी सत्र होंगे जिनमें प्रख्यात अर्थशास्त्री, नीति निर्माता और पेशेवर सम्मेलन के विभिन्न विषयों पर विचार-विमर्श करेंगे।





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
