## Summary

1. **Good glycemic control** during management of COVID
2. **Rational & optimum** use of **corticosteroids**
3. If systemic steroid is used, closely monitor blood sugar and signs of secondary infections.
4. Proper indication, dose and duration of steroid therapy
5. **No antifungal prophylaxis** is recommended
6. Discharge advice about the early symptoms or signs of mucormycosis **crucial 2- 6 weeks** post COVID
7. **Nasal Endoscopic examination post Covid**
