ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY




The Department of Psychology was established as an independent department in 1986. The introduction of various teaching programmes in psychology started in phases with B.A. in 1981, Ph.D. in 1984, B.A. Honors in 1985, M.A. Applied Psychology in 1989, and Advanced Diploma in Counseling Psychology that was initiated in 2001.

Faculty members in the department teach and research in specialization areas of organizational, social, clinical, and counseling in psychology. Activities of the department have been recognized at both national and international levels. M.A. in Applied Psychology is one of the sought after courses at Jamia Millia Islamia and it attracts students from all over the country and abroad.

Focus on internship of students is central to the curriculum and this bridges the gap between theoretical and practical knowledge. Exposure to research activities and report writing by students is given due emphasis as part of their dissertation. This research activity propel students to engage and undertake psychological research.

The Department emphasises on co-curricular activities of students that moulds their overall development as young individuals in society.

Course Structure

The M.A. in Applied Psychology program spans four semesters over two years, integrating advanced psychological theory, research methodology, and specialization in Clinical Psychology, Health Psychology, or Organizational Behavior. The first year establishes a foundational understanding with core subjects like social psychology, cognitive psychology, statistics, peace psychology and psychometrics. Towards the end of the first year, students select their specialization and undergo 60 days of specialized field training. In the second year, students delve deeper into their chosen specialization while also studying core subjects such as personality psychology, counseling psychology and forensic psychology. Practical classes include administering tests like the WAPIS and TAT, as well as learning statistical analysis using SPSS. Internships in relevant organizations and NGOs further bridge theoretical knowledge with practical experience. The program culminates in a dissertation where students carry out research in their specialized area, under the guidance of faculty supervisors. Students are encouraged to publish their findings in peerreviewed journals.

DISSERTATION



The M.A. Applied Psychology course offered at Jamia Millia Islamia incorporates the completion of a dissertation, which holds significant importance. This requirement is mandated for the final year Masters students in order to facilitate the assimilation of their theoretical knowledge, research skills, and subject-specific expertise. Students select a topic from a diverse range of issues or themes that are directly linked to their area of specialization. Throughout the process of writing the dissertation, the students are assigned a faculty member who serves as a facilitator, providing guidance and direction on how to effectively prepare, produce, and write the dissertation. The students adhere to the ethical and professional standards set forth by the American Psychological Association (APA). Engaging in the completion of a dissertation offers students the opportunity to enhance their subject knowledge, as well as improve their analytical and cognitive abilities, ultimately allowing them to present their research to a wider audience.


FOUNDATION DAY 2023







Prof Sheema Aleem has more than 22 years of experience in teaching, research and extension activities. She has published 7 books, around 70 papers in reputed journals and more than 10 chapters in edited books. She has successfully guided 14 research scholars for their Ph D degrees. She has successfully completed research projects, the latest being a Shastri Institutional Research Grant with University of Calgary, Canada. Her special research interests include clinical psychology, personality psychology and positive psychology.



Prof. Md. Ghazi Shahnawaz

Prof. Md. Ghazi Shahnawaz has 30 years of teaching and research experience. He has published 70 research articles in reputed international and national journals and has supervised 15 Ph.Ds. He has completed two major research projects on psychological capital sponsored by ICSSR, Ministry of Education, India. He has also completed an international collaborative project (UGC-UKIERI scheme) as Co-PI. He is currently collaborating as a co-PI on a major project sponsored by ICSSR. Prof Ghazi works mainly in the areas of health psychology, positive psychology at work, psychology of LIEM populations, and the impact of smartphones/new technologies on people's lives.

Prof. Naved Iqbal has 30 years of teaching experience, published 90 research papers in national/international journals, 10 articles in edited books, edited 3 books, and supervised 23 Ph.D. scholars. 
Prof. Samina Bano
