## KUVEMPU UNIVERSITY

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Kuvempu University, Jnana Sahyadri, Shankaraghatta, And Jamia Millia Islamia (A Central University), New Delhi.

- 1. This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into this day 13<sup>th</sup> December 2004, between the Kuvempu University, with its head quarters at Jnana Sahyadri, Shankaraghatta, represented by its Registrar Sri Praveen Chandra which expression shall include its successors, authorised representatives and etc. here-in-after referred as 1<sup>st</sup> party and Jamia Millia Islamia (A Central University), with its head quarters at New Delhi, represented by its Registrar, Sri Z.H. Khan which expression shall include its successors, authorised representatives and etc. here-in-after referred as 2<sup>nd</sup> party witnesseth as under.
- Whereas, both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> party disseminating the knowledge in higher education in general and University education in particular hold the responsibility obligation for National re-construction:
- Whereas, both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> party with mutual understanding agreed to achieve the following common objectives:
  - a) To impart quality higher education in the area of Journalism and Mass Communication at the Post-graduate level through optimum use of human and technical resources available at both the Universities.

- b) To facilitate theoretical and action-oriented research programmes in the field of mass communication with special emphasis on Indian society, both rural and urban.
- c) To facilitate exchange of scholars both at the faculty and student levelbetween these two educational organisations on short-term, reciprocal basis.
- d) To jointly organise seminars, workshops, conferences, fieldwork and other such academic activities to heighten the standards of mass media education in the country.
- To develop academic courses jointly so as to further the causes of both the academic communities.
- f) To develop packages for both formative, summative and evaluative research projects in mass media of communication at global, national and regional levels.
- 4. Whereas Kuvempu University has started a Post Graduate programme of Mass Communication and Journalism the said Department in Jamia Millia Islamia is highly developed and prestigious one. Therefore, Kuvempu University desire that the students admitted to MA (Mass Communication and Journalism) in Kuvempu University should get the benefit of spending at least one semester in Department of Journalism in Jamia Millia Islamia, so that they get advanced training in the field of study. Hence, Kuvempu University has requested Jamia Millia Islamia to permit the University to



send the students for semester study and training in Jamia Millia Islamia. Whereas, Jamia Millia Islamia has agreed to provide the special facility to the students of Kuvempu University.

5. COMMENCEMENT: This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect from the date of signing of MoU.

## 6. EXCHANGE OF STUDIES:

- a) The 1st party and 2nd party on their mutual understanding shall assign the students to each party's institution on reciprocal basis for each semester. The number of students shall be limited to a maximum of 50.
- b) The fee if any, for participation of the students can be decided after mutual discussion.
- c) The students shall be provided with free accomodation by respective Universities.
- d) The travelling expenses shall be borne by the respective institutions.

## 7. EXCHANGE OF FACULTY:

The faculty shall be deputed by the both institutions on reciprocal basis subject to the following conditions to be finalised after mutual discussion which may include.



- The duration of the deputation.
- TA/DA shall be borne by the respective institutions.
- iv) Free accommodation shall be provided by receiving institution.
- SEMINAR, WORKSHOP, CONFERENCE, ETC.: Both the institutions shall organise Seminar, Workshop, Conference, etc. alternatively on mutually agreed dates. The details of workshop shall be worked out by the host institution in consultation with other institution.
- 9. APPLICATION OF REGULATION: The students sponsored by the respective institutions shall be governed by the regulations of the respective institutions regarding admission, examination, award of degrees, etc. The degree shall be awarded by admitting University but a certificate may be issued jointly by both the Universities for students who have received coaching in both the Universities.
- 10. The chairman of departments of both the Universities shall discuss and finalise modalities, in consultation with respective Vice-Chancellor/Registrar.
- 11. BUDGET: Both the Chairpersons/Directors of the concerned Departments of Mass Communication, in consultation with the respective University authorities shall prepare the Annual Budget Estimate every year.
- 12. PAYMENT OF TA, DA AND HONORARIUM: The resource persons, invitees, guests, and other persons invited for the Department shall be paid honorarium, TA, DA, and other allowances, in accordance with the rules of respective Universities.
