

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

JAMIA MILLIA ISLAMIA, NEW DELHI

AND

CENTRAL COUNCIL FOR RESEARCH IN UNANI MEDICINE, NEW DELHI

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of understanding is made on thisday of April 2016 at New Delhi between Jamia Millia Islamia, a statutory Central University, Maulana Mohammad Ali Jauhar Marg, New Delhi – 110025 acting through its Registrar (herein after referred to as J.M.I., party of the **First Part**).

(The expression party of the First Part shall, however, mean and include their successor organizations, appointees, assignees, etc).

AND

The Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine, Jawaharlal Nehru Anusandhan Bhawan, 61-65, Institutional Area, Janakpuri, New Delhi – 110058, an autonomous organization under Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India through its Director General (herein after referred to as C.C.R.U.M., party of the Second Part).

(The expression party of the Second Part shall, however, mean and include their successor organizations, appointees, assignees, etc).

WHEAREAS:-

- **A.** The areas of collaboration between the two organizations will be in the following fields:
 - 1. Develop the Medicinal Plants (Esp. Unani).
 - 2. Conduct the high level Research.
 - 3. Popularize the plants among the students.

- **B.** These research programmes will be executed by joint collaboration of the C.C.R.U.M. and J.M.I. through the following Departments/Centers of J.M.I:
 - 1. Department of Horticulture
 - 2. Department of Biosciences
 - 3. Department of Biotechnology

1. PREAMBLE

i. About the J.M.I.

Jamia Millia Islamia, an institution originally established at Aligarh, India in 1920 and became a Central University by an enactment of the Indian Parliament in 1988. The Jamia has emerged as an outstanding institution of higher learning with distinct and focused academic programmes. Besides offering education from nursery to Class XII and conducting graduate & post graduate courses in nine faculties, the JMI undertakes doctoral programmes in 39 disciplines including Arabic, Persian, Urdu, History, Islamic Studies, West Asian Studies and Sociology etc.

ii. About the C.C.R.U.M.

Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine is an apex research organization for research and development of Unani Medicine under the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India. The Council was established with a view to aid, develop, conduct and coordinate multifaceted research activities in the field of Unani Medicine including Preclinical, Clinical, Drugs Standardization, Survey & Cultivation and Literary & Historical through a network of 23 Research Institute/Units.

iii. Collaboration Mode

- (a) In this present arrangement it is envisaged that J.M.I. provided a piece of land (about one hectare) opposite Teacher's Hostel, to develop the Herbs at Garden by C.C.R.U.M.
- (b) The two Institutes will also venture of collaborative research studies after setting up a model Herbal Garden.



2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF J.M.I.

- i. J.M.I. agrees to provide land (one hectare aprox) opposite Teacher's Hostel with inclusion of present Jamia Herbal Garden.
- ii. J.M.I. agrees to send the students of Jamia School to learn about the Botany of the plants as well as use of Herbs in common disease.
- iii. J.M.I. agrees to conduct high level research on plants (Unani) with the help of Departments of Biosciences and Biotechnology.

3. RESPONSIBILITY OF C.C.R.U.M.

- The C.C.R.U.M. agrees to develop and maintain the Herbal Garden and provide all infrastructure renovation, manpower, technical officers and financial assistance.
- ii. The C.C.R.U.M. agrees to provide the Unani plants through Herbs Garden for the research.
- iii. The C.C.R.U.M. agrees to equally share all kinds of research on plants (Unani) done by J.M.I.
- iv. The C.C.R.U.M. agrees to allow his own Research Officers to work in Garden.

4. MONITORING COMMITTEE

A monitoring committee for this joint collaboration will be constituted by mutual consent of Vice-Chancellor, J.M.I. & Director General, C.C.R.U.M. which will meet periodically and assess the progress of this collaborative process.

5. TERM AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum of understanding shall remain in force for a period of seven years, keeping in view that the scientific research can be carried out only on plants that have attained the age of five years, from the date of its signature and seal and may be extended on evaluation of the project and after having determined mutual benefits accrued the exercise, and may be terminated by either side by giving a six months' Notice to this effect in writing.



6. MISCELLANEOUS

- i. This Memorandum of Undertaking shall require the ratification of the competent Academic / Executive body of the First Party Jamia Millia Islamia and the concerned Academic / Executive body of the Second party Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine.
- ii. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Memorandum shall be governed by and construed solely in accordance with the laws of India, without regard to the conflicts of law provisions thereof, and the courts at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction in this regard.
- iii. The parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall have no legal binding. Nothing mentioned in this Memorandum of Understanding shall deem to constitute partnership between the signing Universities appointing one party as an agent of the other.
- iv. The parties to this Memorandum of Understanding undertake to treat as "confidential and privileged" all information shared by either party in terms of the present Memorandum of Understanding. The terms of Confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.
