

**SYLLABUS FOR ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN TURKISH
(ONE-YEAR COURSE)**

In addition to the revision of the Diploma Course, main emphasis will be on using Turkish in a variety of situations such as; describing the neighbors and neighborhoods; communication ways and instruments; life styles; describing the life styles of different nations; writing and telling the stories; describing a market place, shopping, a businessman; planning the future; describing the different moods of the people and the different characters; writing biographies of different types of persons; responsibilities; illnesses; real life stories; describing the childhood; reservation in a hotel; describing famous parts of the cities; changes in the city from past to present; future's world; new technologies; simple things in people's life; good and bad habits; dreams; mysteries in the life; interviews with different persons; marriage stories; friendship; love stories.

Students will start to practice translating the literary texts and articles from Turkish into English and from English to Turkish. Practice in spoken Turkish.
