104th Foundation Day Celebration of JMI -Events organized on the second day of the three-day celebrations

A number of programmes were organised on the second day of 104th Foundation Day Celebrationof Jamia Millia Islamia(JMI) which began on 27th October, 2024. The three-day celebration will culminate on 29th October. JMI was founded on 29th October, 1920 in Aligarh, UP and shifted to Delhi in 1925.

On 28th October, the Department of Persian organised a one-day National Seminar on "Founders of Jamia" at Mir Anis Hall of the university. Vice Chancellor Prof. Mazhar Asif was the Chief Guest of the inaugural session. This was the first programme he has attended after joining the university as the Vice Chancellor.

During his address which was mainly in Persian language, the Vice Chancellor highlighted roles of legendary founders of JMI in establishing and nurturing the historical institution. He emphasized on the role of teachers in shaping an institution. A university is a place where students learn good manners, courtesy, respect, and appropriateness.
