Jamia Millia Islamia signs MoU with Hanyang University Republic of Korea

Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) entered into an academic and research collaboration with Hanyang University, Republic of Korea. The collaboration shall provide opportunity to develop programs, hold seminars and exchange visits of faculty as well as students. The academic interaction and intellectual assimilation would also lead to synergise joint research, cultural events and workshops.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Ki-Jeong Lee, President, Hanyang University expressed his optimism that this collaboration will strengthen bonds between the two universities through furtherance in education and research.

Hanyang University (HYU) is a prestigious private research university in South Korea, with its main campus in Seoul and a second campus, ERICA (Education Research Industry Cluster at Ansan), in Ansan. The university has also been consistently ranked amongst leading universities in the world by the renowned international ranking agencies as a comprehensive research-intensive institution. The university has received the prestigious "Research award of President of India" twice and many of its students are recipients of Prime Minister's Research Fellowship.
