JMI's Syed Abid Husain Senior Secondary School successfully conducts draw of lots for class Prep and class 1 admissions; Draw fully live streamed

Jamia Millia Islamia's (JMI) Syed Abid Husain Senior Secondary School successfully conducted the draw of lots for admission to Class Prep at 10:00 am and Class 1 at 2:30 pm on March 8, 2025. The lottery draw was done in front of the School admission committee, Principals of JMI schools, applicants and their parents. Prof. Md. Mahtab Alam Rizvi, Registrar JMI and Chairman, School Admission Committee, informed the audience that the seats in class Prep have been doubled from last year and that the university administration was exploring possibilities to increase more seats in other classes of the school. In order to maintain the highest levels of transparency and fairness, as also to provide equal opportunity to all applicants, the lottery slips were kept in a sealed box which was opened by the Prof. Md Mahtab Alam Rizvi and Dr. Ahteshamul Haque, Hony Deputy Controller of Examinations, JMI in front of all those present for the draw. Furthermore, the entire event was live streamed on YouTube in order to ensure complete transparency and fairness of the admission process that was underway.

The event began with a recitation of the Holy Quran after which the principal of Syed Abid Hussain, Ms. Shagufta Shandar Khan, warmly welcomed all distinguished guests and parents. The total no. of applications received for class Prep were 2611 and the total no. of applications received for class 1st were 2916. Total number of seats filled through the lottery in Prep was 80 (which increased from 40 last year) and seats in class 1st were 40.

The presence of school authorities, university officials, and parents emphasized and testified to the school's commitment to maintaining integrity and fairness in its admissions. The school admission committee members appreciated the sincerity and efforts by the Principal, Syed Abid Hussain Senior Secondary school and other staff members for successfully conducting the lottery draw in a smooth, transparent and efficient manner.

Syed Abid Husain Senior Secondary School of JMI was established in 1988 as a Middle school and transitioned into a Senior Secondary school in 1991. As a co-educational, English-medium school, it provides quality education to approximately 2,400 students
